We have developed a unique modular timber decking system for the caravan and leisure home industry that revolutionises the way decking surrounds are installed on parks throughout the UK and Europe. We're timber engineering specialists and we have years of experience supplying to the industry.

Our modular decking system is **highly customisable** and has different modules available use to create a bespoke decking arrangement to suit any space.

All modules are **quick and easy to assemble** and are treated to UC3 (Use Class 3) for resistance to weather and insects. As well as the timber being treated, all of our core modules are constructed with DeckWright's Anti-Slip decking boards, ensuring the **modules are safe to use, year-round**.

Another benefit to our system is the durability and rigidity of the modules. Each module is assembled in-house and goes **through a two-stage durability test** before leaving the factory. This solid construction is just one of the ways we're set apart from other decking providers on the market and will always be a core foundation of the product moving forward.

The advantage of using this decking system is its modular design, offering a variety of final product layouts and designs. This is a huge benefit to park owners and end users as different homes on parks are often very different when it comes to layouts, door locations and park home / caravan shapes.

Why Choose Timber Over Composite?

A common misconception is that composite decking is environmentally friendly. While some of the products that go into making the composite decking are recycled, the products are still plastic and non-renewable products. Composite decking production is extremely harmful to the environment especially during the melting and moulding process, to produce the boards.

Our timber decking system is made from sustainable timber products and with timber actually storing carbon, the carbon emissions for the manufacture of our modular system are vastly reduced.

Customisable Modular Decking & Access

With the growing need for bespoke decking surrounds for various caravans and leisure homes across the UK and Europe, our modular system is a perfect solution for parks to offer their end-users that provides a natural aesthetic whilst remaining durable with year-round usability.

Our system offers various modular components that fix together to create bespoke decking areas and access. Modules are fitted with steadies to help adapt to uneven surfaces.

Anti-Slip Technology Safe, Weatherproof & Reliable

Our modular decking system features DeckWright's anti-slip technology for each board used in all of our core modules. This weatherproof, treated product meets the demanding and varied weather conditions of the UK and Europe.



Each of the grooved boards consist of two anti-slip strips enhancing user safety. To be classed as 'non-slip decking' the PTV (Pendulum Test Value) minimum requirements are 35.

With safety at the heart of our decking system, the **DeckWright product boards have a measured PTV of 71**. With our test value of 71, we far exceed minimum requirements and stand notably higher than other similar products.

DeckWright's deck boards are often found in full timber decking areas, providing a year-round anti-slip solution. Using these high-quality boards for our decking step product provides protection against damp weather, algae and moss all with minimal yearly maintenance requirements.

Core Modules

Decking Podiums

Our main core module is our decking podium. Available in a range of timber species, this module can be used either as one individual decking piece or can be paired with other decking podiums to create a larger decked area.

Constructed from use class 3 treated timber, all of the decking boards are treated with DeckWright anti-slip technology, offering year-round use, with minimal slip risk.




Decking Steps

Our step product range comes in two widths; our single step or double step. Each fit perfectly when paired with the decking module. Single steps can be mounted to either the short face or long face of the decking podium. Double width steps are for mounting to the long face of the decking.

The steps can also be used as free-standing steps and can be fixed with the provided fixing kit to a vertical structure for added stability like a park home or caravan.

The steps benefit from DeckWright's anti-slip technology offering a sure footed experience for end users.

As well as coming in two widths, the step modules are also offered with hand rails available on one side or both sides. With the double width step, you can choose to have a middle hand rail too.

Access Ramps

The access ramp module can be used on its own paired directly with a caravan, park home or lodge or paired with our decking podiums. The height of the ramp is designed to mount to the height of the decking podium.

Commonly used by end users with varying levels of mobility or users with push prams and bikes, this module is a great access addition for families of all ages. This module's usability is again, enhanced with the DeckWright anti-slip decking boards offering added grip.



Add-On Modules

Gates

As well as our core modules, we also have add-on modules which are smaller components that further complement existing module structures.

Gates are an add-on often paired with our steps and ramps to help with security and benefit end users with small children or pets.



Railings

Railings are a key aspect of our modular experience and are often packaged in with other modules as standard, however we do offer extra railings where needed. Common uses for add-on railing modules are for creating enclosed hot tub areas within a decking area.
